Public Notice to Customers of Violation

Type of Violation: Chlorine Monitoring, Routine (DBP), Major
Failure to submit Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report
Time Period of Violation: Second Quarter 2014: 4/01/14 – 6/30/14

The North Rural WSC water system, PWS ID 1820009, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period: Second Quarter 2014, 4/01/14 – 6/30/14

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

We will ensure that all reports are completed and submitted on time to the TCEQ.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
